



## CEMENT SMEAR TILE CLEANER

### Characteristic product properties

- Eco-friendly.
- Ready to use, can be diluted.
- Colourless.
- Walls and floors.
- Indoor and outdoor use.

### Applications

For removing cement smears left behind on ceramic tiles. Degreasing existing ceramic tiles that have been laid using a suitable Omnibind primer. CTR Cement Smear Tile Cleaner is not suitable for use on natural stone.

### Suitable surfaces

- Ceramic tiles

### Alternative products/applications

- For degreasing water-resistant surfaces such as marble, linoleum, terrazzo and wooden floors, swimming pools and concrete enamel: CLEANER omnibind.
- Industrial cleaners are necessary for heavy oils and greases.

### Surface preparation

- Remove any loose material, serious dirt, and grease residue.
- Tape off or carefully protect areas not to be treated.

### Application instructions

- Always wear protective equipment for the eyes and skin. Wash hands thoroughly after working with this product.

### Removing cement smears

Find out beforehand whether the tiles can be treated with CTR Cement Smear Tile Cleaner.

- Wet the surface to be cleaned beforehand with clean tap water, ensuring that the wet joints are protected from the cleaner
- Depending on the severity of the cement smears left behind, a dilution of 100 ml CTR in 2 litres of clean tap water is recommended for removing light cement smears. For tough cement smears, apply undiluted, if required.
- Spread the CTR Cement Smear Tile evenly on the surface. An effervescent effect is created after allowing to work in with cement smears. Leave to work in and brush if necessary. Remove the dirt loosened. Always rinse well afterwards with clean tap water and dry the surface well. If necessary, the treatment can be repeated.

### Degreasing existing ceramic tiles

- Depending on the severity of the soiling, a dilution of approx. 100 ml CTR in 5 litres of clean tap water is recommended for degreasing existing ceramic tiles. Apply the mixture with a sponge or mop (floor) to the surface to be cleaned. Allow to work in, brushing if necessary. Remove the dirt loosened. Always rinse well afterwards with clean tap water and dry the surface well. If necessary, the treatment can be repeated.
- Do not apply in frosty conditions. This applies both for the surface and ambient temperature.

### Equipment to be used

- Sponge, brush, mop.
- Dry cloth.

### Consumption

Due to the wide variety of possible surface types and the degree of soiling, actual consumption of the product is variable. See application instructions for the application in question.

### Equipment clean-up

After use, rinse with clean tap water.



**Product composition**

CTR Cement Smear Tile Cleaner is a factory-made cleaner and degreaser with biodegradable surface-active substances, as stated in Directive (EC) n° 648/2004 in relation to detergents.
